FRIDAY 7TH MARCH 2025

All animals are to be registered full blood Boer Goats.

Classes are based on age of goat on Show Day.

Judging to start at Boer Goat Ring located in the Boer Goat Arena.11.00am. Animals to be penned by 10am

All livestock entries close with the Livestock Secretary on FRIDAY 7TH FEBRUARY 2025.

Entry Fees must accompany all entries. Late Entries will be charged an additional \$15.

Security staff will be on duty from Thursday 6pm – 7am Friday; Friday 6pm – Saturday 7am. Saturday 6pm – Sunday 9am.

PROTESTS, JUDGE'S & COMMITTEE'S RIGHTS

- BG1a. The Stewards in the various classes are enjoined and empowered to prevent any persons interfering with the Judge during adjudication and no exhibitor or other person other than the Judge, Stewards and Livestock Secretary will be permitted to go inside the ring while the exhibits are being judged, except in such cases as the Stewards may deem necessary.
- BG1b. The Committee may reserve the right to allot Specials in lieu of prize money mentioned in this schedule.
- BG1c. All Protests to be lodged with the Livestock Secretary accompanied with a deposit of \$50, within half an hour of adjudication and if, in the opinion of the Committee such protest is deemed frivolous, the deposit to be forfeited.

- BG1d. The Committee will not, under any circumstances be responsible for any loss, damage or mis-delivery of stock or other exhibits at the Show.
- BG1e. Any person infringing the rules of the Society will be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$50. The attention of exhibitors is particularly directed to the foregoing provisions which will be strictly enforced or will revert to the funds of the Society.
- BG1f. Any exhibitor or person in any way interfering with or using improper language to the Judge or any officer of the Society in, or as to, the execution of their duty, or being guilty of improper conduct on the Showground, may be disqualified from exhibiting in future shows of the Society, and if exhibiting at this Show, may forfeit all prizes they have won.
- BG1g. The decision of the Committee shall be final on any subject on Show Day.
- BG1h. Officials have the power in Boer Goat Section to move stock to their correct classes with the approval and on advice of Judge.
- BG1i. Any person having been expelled from membership, or disqualified from exhibiting, riding or competing by any kindred association shall not be allowed to become a member, or to exhibit, ride or compete at this Society's exhibitions, until such expulsion be rescinded or such disqualification be removed, provided such expulsion or disqualification be confirmed by the Executive of this Society.
- BG1j. Arrears: No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions or any other show charge is eligible to compete at any A & P Show. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction will be lifted.
- BG1k. The Judge is empowered to withhold the prizemoney in any department in which there are not sufficient funds.
- BG1I. The RAS In-Line Resolution Process system applies at this show; please read full rule wording under the General Information Section of this schedule.



GROUND RULES

- BG2a. Entries to be on the ground, and stock yarded by 10.00am Friday. Judging to commence at 11.00am sharp and on no account will be delayed for exhibits not to hand. All judges are requested to be on the ground at 10.30am.
- BG2b. No exhibits can be removed from the ground before 4pm except with an order from the Chief Steward.
- BG2c Ticket allocation One Two Day pass for every 4 animals.
- BG2d Additional passes purchased on lineFor more information, please visit the website -www.wanakashow.co.nz
- BG2e. Any animal within the Show Grounds from 11.00am Wednesday 5th March till 9.00am Sunday 9th March is protected by our Animal Welfare Policy.

SPECIAL PRIZES AND ENTRIES

- BG3a. Any commendable extra stock to receive honorary mention.
- BG3b. All Livestock prize money will be directed credited after the show. Please include your name and bank account number on your Entry Form.
- BG3c. All Boer Goat entries close with the Livestock Secretary on FRIDAY 7TH FEBRUARY, 2025.
- BG3d. Entry Fees must accompany all entries. Late Entries will be charged an additional \$15.
- BG3e. Refund of entry fees will only be considered if scratchings are made officially with the Livestock Secretary either prior to the Show or in sufficient time to avoid disruption to the smooth running of the competition. i.e., full refund if scratching is made before Friday 21st February. 75% refund if scratching is made before Friday 28th February 2025, 4pm. No refund will be given after this time unless a vet certificate is produced.
- BG3f. If a veterinary certificate is produced, refunds will be in full.

SHOW CANCELLATION POLICY

BG4a. If the Show is abandoned or postponed due to any reason beyond the control of the Society, the Society is under no obligation to refund in whole or in part any payments made by the Exhibitors. Any refund will be at the sole discretion of the Society.

- BG4b. The Society will not be liable for any delay or failure to perform its obligations to the extent that such delay or failure results from a Force Majeure Event and while the Force Majeure Event continues. The Society will give the Exhibitor written notice as soon as reasonably possible containing details of the circumstances giving rise to the Force Majeure Event. The Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees that it will not be entitled to any reimbursement of any fees paid where a Force Majeure Event disrupts the Show. The Society may in its absolute discretion refund in whole or in part, any payment made by the Exhibitor - or waive any payment the Exhibitor is liable to make under these Terms.
- BG4c. For the purposes of clause B4b "Force Majeure" means an event or occurrence which is beyond a party's reasonable control (including, without limitation, acts of God or the public enemy, flood, earthquake, storm, cyclone, tornado, hurricane, lightning, fire, explosion, epidemic, war, embargoes, riot or civil disturbances, sabotage, expropriation, confiscation or requisitioning of facilities, the imposition of disabling exchange rate controls, orders or temporary or permanent injunctions of any duly constituted court of competent jurisdiction); and which the affected party could not have reasonably foreseen or taken reasonable measures to prevent.
